CHAIR'S FUND

Eligibility

ELIGIBILITY

- The young person applying must be a maximum of 25 years old
- The applicant must be a close family member of a tenant of Hillhead Housing Association, whether the tenant is a parent, guardian or grandparent
- The applicant's main home at the time of the application must also be a Hillhead Housing Association property.
- Formal proof or evidence of participation in the event/activity for which the funding is required must be supplied
- No more than one application may be made in each financial year (April 1st to March 31st)
- The applicant agrees to participate in any publicity arranged by the Association in connection with a successful award unless this would risk the safety or wellbeing of that young person in any way.

FUNDING

- Applications must specify precise costs expected or incurred.
- A maximum of £500 will be granted to successful applicants
- Payment will be made via cheque or bank transfer to the tenant who is the relative of the applicant or directly to the appropriate organisation. This will be at the discretion of Hillhead Housing Association.

CRITERIA

- Applications are to be made on the official application form
- Applications will be dealt with on a first-come, first-served basis
- Applications must demonstrate that the funding will help the child/young adult either to undertake educational or vocational training, or to attend a character-forming event personal development activity. This includes participation fees, accommodation and subsistence, travel and, in particular, equipment costs
- We reserve the right to contact you for further information as deemed necessary
- All requests for funding will be considered by the chair of the board of management.
- Any award made is at the absolute discretion of the chair and their decision is final
